

## Settingrior Standard Awning (Manual Up and Down Limits




Initiate programming by pressing both the (△) (Up) and (△) (Down) buttons at the same time until the motor jogs.



STEP 2


Check the direction of operation. Press and hold the button and confirm it moves the motor out (the motor will be in momentary fashion). To change the direction press and hold the [my] (Stop) button until the motor jogs.



STEP 3

Bring the motor to your desired upper limit.

Press and hold both the wand buttons until the motor begins to move down, then release. Stop the motor where the lower limit should be set, you can adjust by pressing the or buttons.



STEP 4
Press and hold the and (A) buttons until the motor begins to move up. The motor will stop at

the original

upper point.




STEP 5

Press and hold the Program button on the back of the transmitter until the motor jogs. It will now operate in a maintained fashion. Double check limits as a precaution.

## STEP 1


Initiate programming by pressing both the

Bring the motor to your desired down limit. Press and hold both the and buttons until the motor begins to move up, then release.




STEP 4

STEP 5

Press and hold the button until the motor moves to set its upper limit automatically and confirm setting.



STEP 6
